

2019 Point-in-Time Count C


The Point-in-Time (PIT) Count is a measure of the number of people counted as experiencing homelessness on a single night in January each year, providing a "snapshot" of homelessness from year to year.

1,843

People were identified as experiencing homelessness in the Eastern PA Continuum of Care on January 23, 2019.

Housing Inventory



75% increase in Rapid Rehousing beds from 2018 to 2019 (+537 beds).

6% increase in overall year-round beds for people experiencing homelessness from 2018 to 2019. (+239 beds).


