

## Western PA Continuum of Care 2019 Point-in-Time Count


The Point-in-Time (PIT) Count is a measure of the number of people counted as experiencing homelessness on a single night in January each year, providing a "snapshot" of homelessness from year to year.

727

people were identified as experiencing homelessness in the Western PA Continuum of Care on January 23, 2019.



There has been a **26% decline in homelessness** in the Western PA CoC from 2016 to 2019.


Housing Inventory

**9% increase in Rapid Rehousing beds** from 2018 to 2019 (+45 beds).

**6% increase in overall year-round beds** for people experiencing homelessness (+159 beds).

## **Subpopulations**

Veterans: 88 people (**26% decrease** since 2016)

 Families: 263 people in families > 154 children and 109 adults (37% decrease since 2016)

Chronically homeless: 17 people (47% decrease since 2016)

## Unsheltered Homelessness by County

Overall, unsheltered homelessness in the Western CoC declined by 51% since 2016 (69 people in 2016 and 34 people in 2019).
