The Funding Committee identified issues with consistent underspending and underutilization of this project. The Funding Committee notified the applicant of full reallocation on 9/22/21. Per the Funding Policies, the grantee submitted an appeal. The Funding Committee reviewed the appeal and determined that a partial reallocation would be made (versus full). The grantee was notified of this appeal decision and their partial reallocation on 9/29/21.




