RENEWAL PROJECTS: STATUS UPDATE

- **Renewal Project Evaluation and Scoring**
 - Preliminary Scores were released on Friday, July 10
 - Questions/reporting errors due by Monday, July 20 at 12pm
 - Appeals due by Tuesday, July 21 at 5pm
 - Final renewal project scoring to be released once appeals are processed by the CoC Funding Committees
- **E-snaps just opened last night**
 - Framework will be logging in to look for updates within the application
 - Framework will be sending out instructions asap, along with a timeline

RENEWAL PROJECTS: TRANSITION PROJECTS

Details about Transition Projects

- Project must apply as “new” in e-snaps
- With FY2026 CoC funding, the project winds down the current project component, and starts the new project component
- The budget must stay the same (this year)
- If additional money needed in services (for example), would likely need to reduce number of units

RENEWAL PROJECTS: TRANSITION PROJECTS

- **Example:**

Rapid Re-Housing	Transitional Housing
Project budget = \$200,000 Rental Assistance = 10 units Supportive Services = \$50,000 Admin = \$20,000	Project budget = \$200,000 Rental Assistance/ Leasing = 9 units Supportive Services = \$63,000 Admin = \$20,000
